## **2007-2008 Shipping Information**

We can provide shipping for exhibitor materials between all the WGH on Tour Shows. **The price remains the same as last season despite the increased fuel costs**. The following are the specifics of the shipping program:

- Includes shipping from iHobbyexpo, or Trainfest to all 6 WGH on Tour shows ending with the Louisville Show
- As an option, we can also receive it at our facility in suburban Chicago and transport it to Schaumburg at **NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE**. For this option we would need the material no later than 11/15/07. You can also ship directly to Schaumburg but you must specify delivery on Thursday November 22 or Friday November 23, 2007.
- After the Louisville Show you can have your material shipped back to you, or to your next event from either Louisville or our Chicago facility.
- If you desire we may be able to accommodate special requests, such as shipping back after Kansas City, or shipping to/from other shows.
- Charges are based per skid. All materials must be on a skid or on wheels. Skids must be able to be moved with a pallet jack.
- The maximum skid size is 42" x 42".
- The maximum skid weight is 900 pounds (contact us if you need an exception).
- The maximum skid height is 6.5 feet.
- Items larger than a skid can be transported but will be charges by the number of 42"x42" skid spaces the material takes in the truck
- You must transport the same amount of material between all shows, if the amount varies we will need to charge by the maximum space used, because we have to buy truck space accordingly
- All pricing is based on material to be moved to all 6 shows, please contact us for pricing for less than 6 shows, or if you have special requests. Price is \$295.00 per skid per show. **Price includes all drayage charges, we deliver to your booth and pick up from your booth.**
- We need to know your shipping participation by 10/15/2007 so we can rent enough trucks.

We think this is a very attractive program, as you know many shows charge 50 cents or more per pound just for drayage, **our program transports your material for less than most shows charge just for drayage.** If you need a custom proposal or have questions, please feel free to contact us at 630-279-5094.

While we will also do our best to have the materials at the shows on time, we cannot accept any liability for failure for goods to arrive on time. We are giving your materials the same treatment we give our own show materials, so we do not anticipate any issues, but unexpected problems can occur. We will invoice you \$295 per skid per show for each of the six shows. Invoices will be sent at the conclusion of each show.

In no case shall our liability be greater than the amount paid for shipping.
